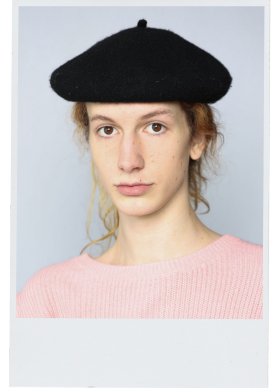
Oliver Blair

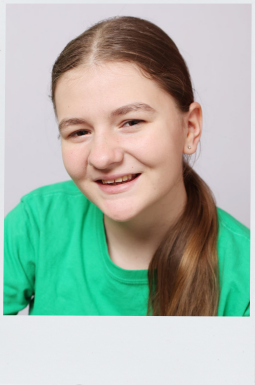
Casey Gnoato

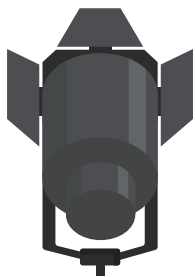

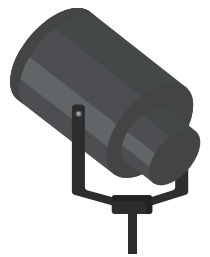
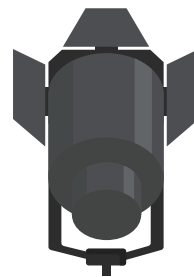


Ruby Jones

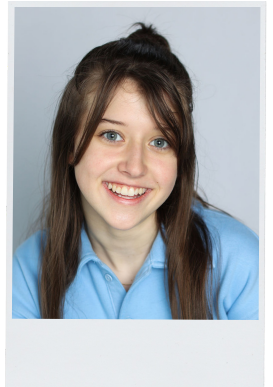
Emma Lake

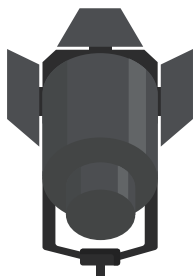
Jenna Lamb

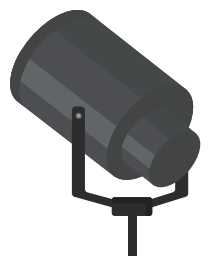
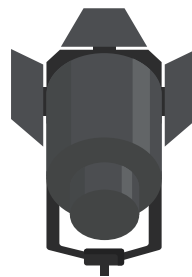


Amy Lloyd

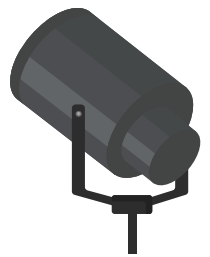
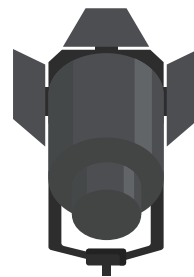
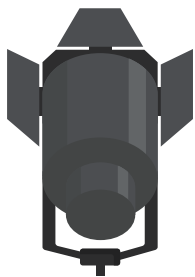


Lauren Warick

Chris Adams - Teacher

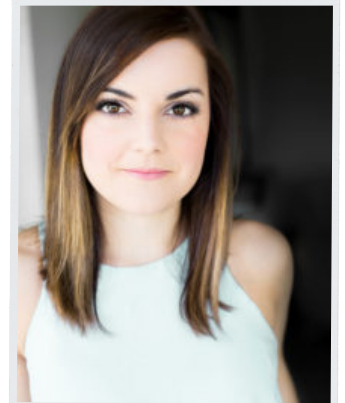

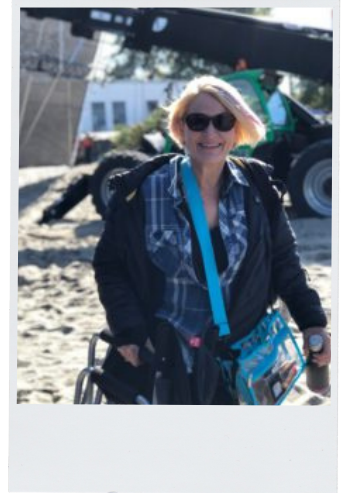
Holly Bradbury - Student Teacher

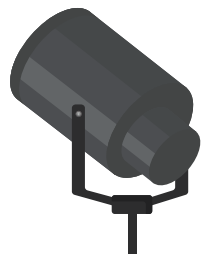
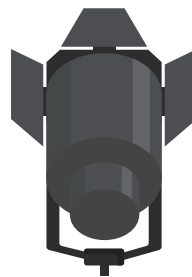
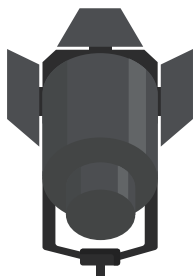


John Bradbury - Set Construction

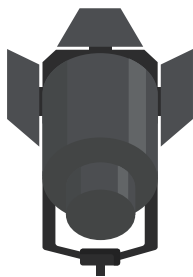

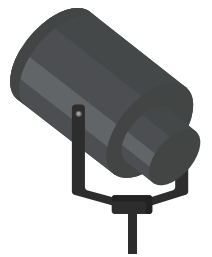
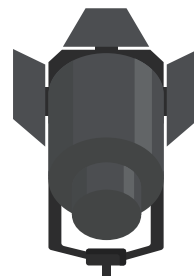


Dan Wiebe - ASM/Set Design/Construction

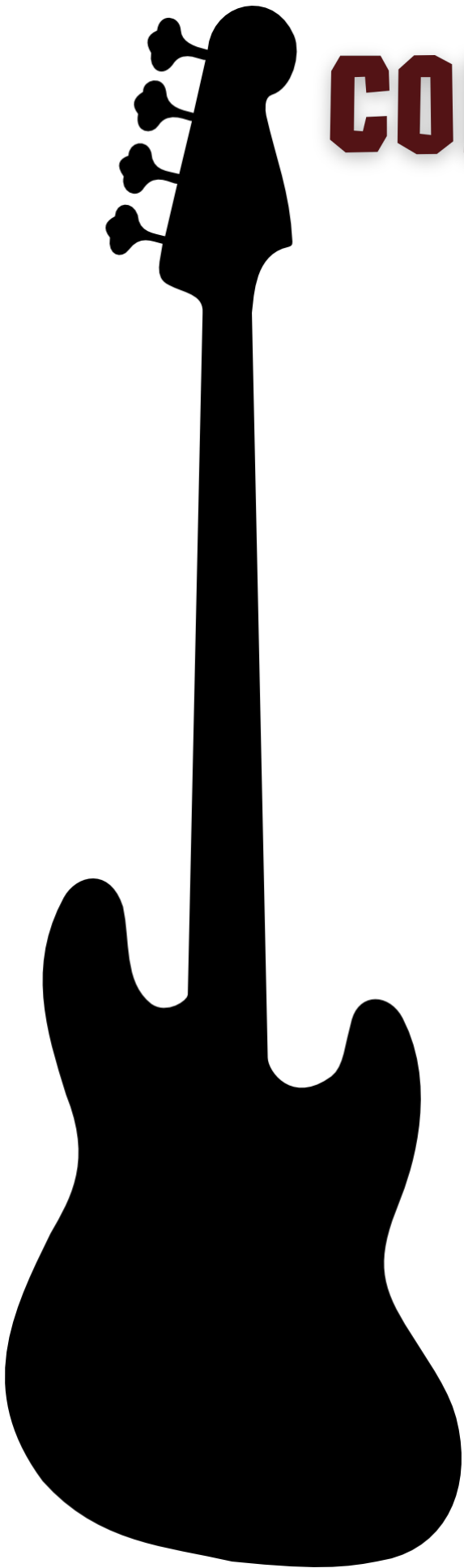
